MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- A Bachelor Degree in related field with minimum CGPA of 2.75 out of 4.00 or its equivalent qualification as accepted by the Senate; OR
- A Bachelor Degree in related field with CGPA below 2.75 out of 4.00 but above 2.50 out of 4.00 or its equivalent qualification can be accepted, subject to a minimum of 5 years working experience in relevant field.

In addition, applicants must also fulfill the entry requirements for admission into the partner university's master programme.
