

TAR UC-MSEF Scholarship

(Set up under TAR UC-TAA Scholarship)

TAR UC-MSEF Scholarship is established to provide scholarship to needy and deserving students to pursue their further studies in TAR UC and to cultivate the spirit of volunteerism.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Must be a TAR UC's full time Diploma or Degree student with minimum CGPA of **2.7500***, and
2. Must be a Malaysian citizen, and
3. Financial needy, and/or
4. Active participation in extra-curricular activities.

**Note:*

- Existing Diploma/Bachelor Degree's students refer to the latest Diploma/Degree semester's CGPA.

- New Degree students promoted from Foundation / Diploma refer to the Foundation / Diploma's final semester's CGPA.

- New Diploma students (Year 1 Sem 1) refer to SPM results: minimum 5As.

Value of Scholarship Award:

University's tuition fees as per the university's bill for the duration of the programme.

Volunteer for Community Service:

The Scholar shall perform and complete community service in NGOs/charity organizations to be prescribed by MSEF within 4 years upon graduation. The number of hours for the community services are as shown below:

Duration of Scholarship Awards	Total No. of Hours for Voluntary Community Service	
1 year	500 Hours	The Scholar may volunteer (subject always to satisfactory academic performances) for the community services during his/her university years for not more than 1/3 of the total number of required hours and continue the services upon graduation.
1 year and 1 or 2 semester(s)	750 Hours	
2 years	1000 Hours	
2 years and 1 or 2 semeste(s)	1250 Hours	
3 - 3.9999 years	1500 Hours	There will be no salary or allowance payable by MSEF for the community service abovestated.
4 - 4.9999 years	1800 Hours	
5 years and above	2000 Hours	

Other Terms and Conditions:

1. The scholarship will be reviewed on an annual basis and any extensions for a successive year will be granted at the absolute discretion of TAR UC and subject to the scholar's satisfactory performance and conduct.
2. Scholar must maintain good academic results or otherwise every semester.
3. Scholar shall not change his/her programme of studies unless with written permission from the TAR UC.
4. Scholar may be required to reimburse the scholarship award amount received up to date of termination / withdrawal / suspension, in case of termination / withdrawal / suspension from TAR UC.
5. Scholar shall not be simultaneously receiving other scholarship unless with written approval from TAR UC.
