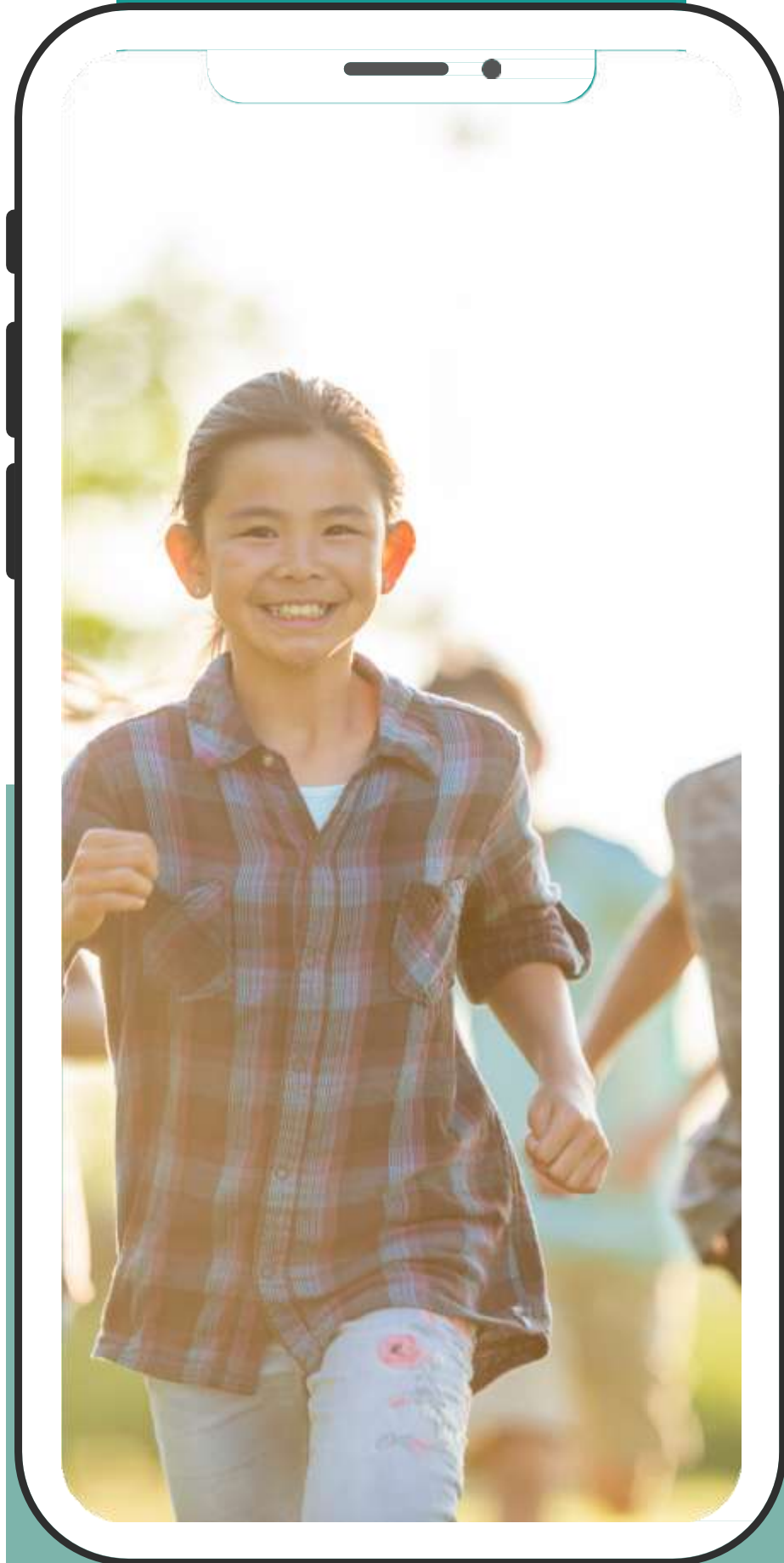

Overview

The MIVA SiYuan Scholarship, established by the Malaysian Social Entrepreneurs Foundation (MSEF), aims to support outstanding youth from disadvantaged backgrounds—particularly OKU (persons with disabilities), youth from welfare homes, and the B40 group. The program provides full scholarships combined with volunteer service training and empowerment opportunities, nurturing future leaders with strong social responsibility.



Mission

Support disadvantaged students to complete their education through scholarships and volunteering, fostering their social responsibility and gratitude, and empowering them to give back to society.

Create a caring and responsible youth volunteer community where beneficiaries become helpers, promoting social fairness and positive change

Advance Sustainable Public Good

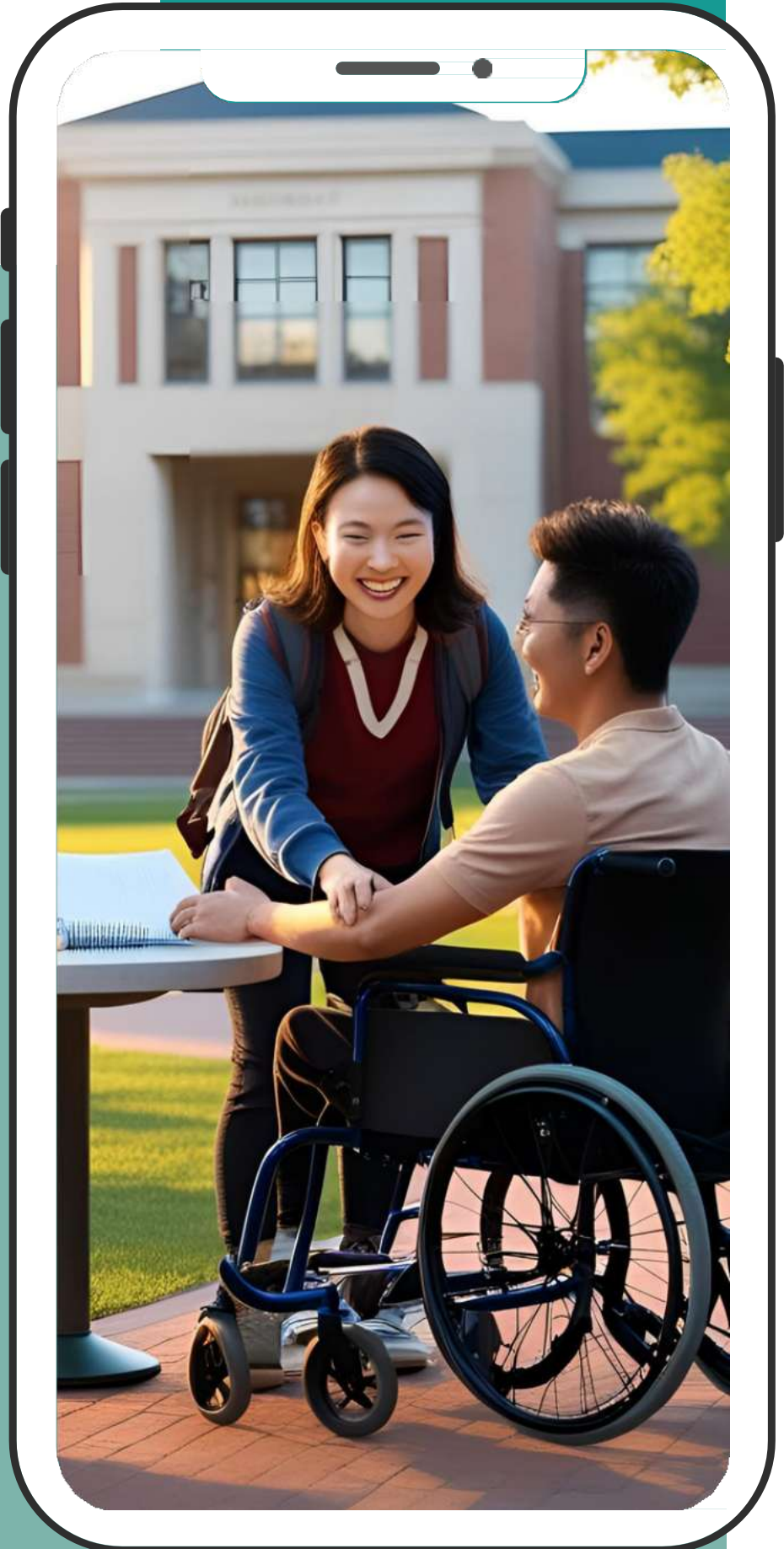

Scholarship Details

01 Scholarship Type

Full Tuition Scholarship

03 Purpose

To support students by reducing their financial burden on tuition

02 Coverage

Covers 100% of tuition fees for the entire study duration

04 Eligibility

Awarded based on academic performance, leadership potential, financial need, and a strong passion for community service and volunteerism

- *If awarded the MIVA SiYuan Scholarship, you must decline other tuition-fee-based scholarships (excluding PTPTN loans). Financial aid for living expenses is still allowed.*
- *Once notified of the award, recipients must submit a written acceptance within 30 days. Failure to do so will be regarded as forfeiture of the scholarship.*
- *You must immediately notify MIVA if your funding status changes*

Who Can Apply ?

A simple guide to the 3 eligible applicant groups



Youth with physical disabilities

Youth students who hold an "OKU card" issued by the Department of Social Welfare (JKM).



Welfare home resident

Youth from registered welfare homes or orphanages, or those who left after 18 and are continuing studies.



Youth from B40 families.

Household income must fall under the B40 category with official proof required.



Basic Eligibility Criteria

- Malaysians citizens, aged 25 or below
- Officially accepted into a local college or university
- Academic performance: minimum CGPA 2.75/SPM min. 3A
- Good character, responsible, caring, and empathetic
- From an economically disadvantaged family
- Preference given to those with volunteer experience or a strong interest in community service
- Applicants may apply for other scholarships or financial aid at the time of application. However, if awarded the MIVA SiYuan Scholarship, they must not concurrently receive any other tuition-related financial assistance, as the MIVA SiYuan Scholarship provides 100% tuition coverage.
- Applicants must disclose all other aid they are applying for or receiving



Priority Applicant



1. Individuals with volunteer or community service experience
2. Applicants who have demonstrated leadership or initiative
3. Candidates with clear personal development goals and a willingness to grow
4. Individuals with a strong sense of social responsibility and alignment with volunteer values
5. OKU youth (must submit OKU card)
6. Youth from welfare home or without family support
7. B40 youth with demonstrated potential and responsibility

Application Procedure

- **Announcement**

MIVA and partners will announce the scholarship to eligible students.

- **Submission**

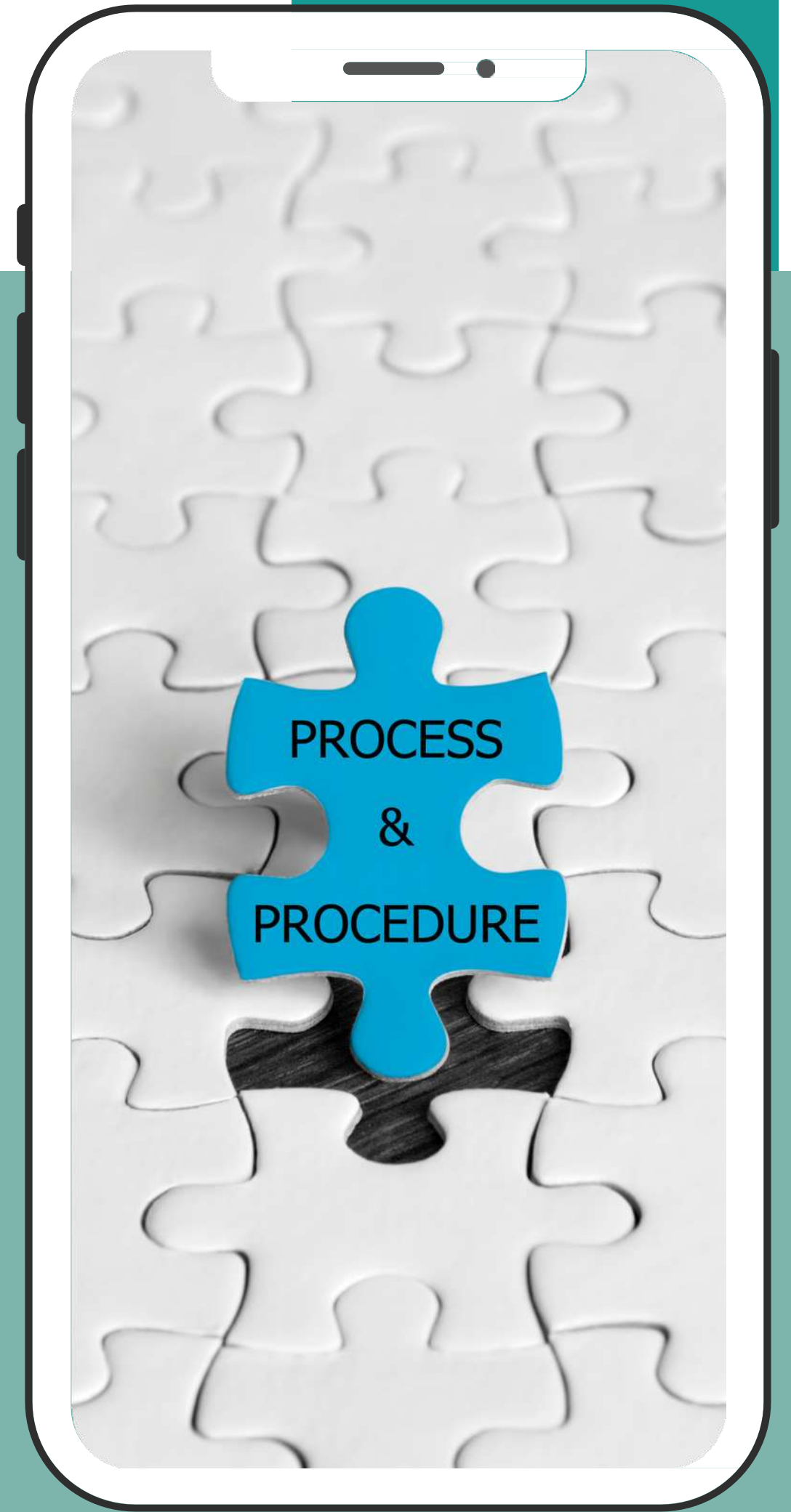
Applicants must complete the online form and submit required documents before the deadline.

- **Verification**

MIVA will review documents for eligibility and completeness.

- **Declaration**

Applicants must declare other scholarships or aid they are applying for or receiving.



Selection Process

- **Initial Screening**

Applications are screened based on eligibility: academic results, financial need, and volunteer experience.

- **Committee Evaluation**

Shortlisted candidates are assessed on leadership, service commitment, and personal goals.

- **Interview (if needed)**

Some may be invited for further interview.

- **Final Decision**

Recipients are selected based on overall fit with MIVA's mission and will be notified.

- **Notification**

Recipients must confirm acceptance in writing within 30 days of notification, or the scholarship will be forfeited.



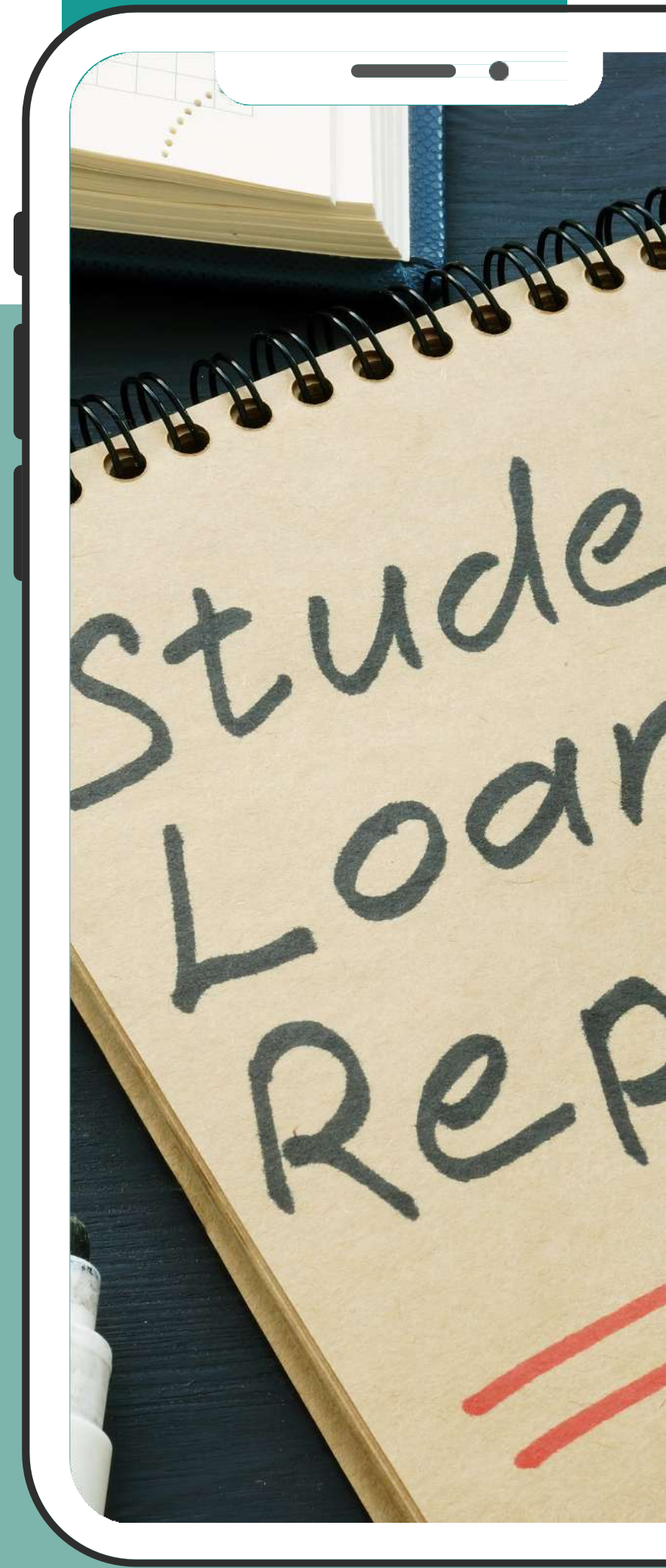
Obligation of Scholarship Recipients & Important Notes



- Scholarship funds are transferred directly to the recipient's institution bank account
- The scholarship is strictly for tuition fee payment only
- All recipients must register as MIVA volunteers to ensure proper tracking of service hours and activities
- Recipients must complete the required number of community service hours and submit a service report by the end of each semester
- Recipients must maintain a minimum CGPA of 2.75 every semester
- Community service performance is a key criterion for continued funding
- Failure to fulfill the required service hours, submit a valid report on time, and maintain the minimum CGPA 2.75 will result in the cancellation of the scholarship and full repayment of the funds received for that semester

Repayment Policy of MIVA SiYuan Scholarship

The MIVA SiYuan Scholarship is a non-repayable financial aid; however, recipients are required to complete a designated number of community service hours as a form of social contribution. This service commitment serves as an alternative to monetary repayment, fostering a spirit of gratitude and social responsibility among scholarship beneficiaries. If the required service hours are not completed within 2 years after stopping the scholarship application, it will be considered a breach of agreement, and the full scholarship amount will need to be refunded. The Malaysian Social Entrepreneurs Foundation (MSEF) reserves the right to take legal action if necessary.



Community Service Hours Guidelines & Submission Rules

Total required service hours	Each semester, recipients must complete 200 hours of community service. These hours can be accumulated within 2 years after the final semester of receiving the scholarship
Minimum hours per semester	A minimum of 50 hours per semester is required:
Accepted type of service	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • MSEF, MIVA project • MIVA partner NGO programs • Non-MIVA activities (pre-approved by MIVA)
Submission procedure	<p>Within 14 days after each semester ends.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. email reports to msef.siyuan@gmail.com 2. send confirmation message to MIVA hotline 011-5880 5897
Reporting Non-MIVA Activities	Submit activity details (organization, scope, dates) at least one week in advance via email and WhatsApp for MIVA approval
If not fulfilled or reported	<p>If any of the following occur without a valid reason:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum of 50 service hours not completed in a semester; • Report not submitted on time; • Academic performance falls below a cumulative GPA (CGPA) of 2.75; <p>Failure to meet the required service hours, submit a valid report on time, or maintain the minimum academic requirement without a valid reason will result in the cancellation of the scholarship and full repayment for that semester.</p>



Documents Required for MIVA SiYuan Scholarship Application



Applicants are required to prepare and submit the following documents:

- Completed Application Form
- Latest Academic Transcript / Result Slip
- University Admission Letter / Proof of Enrollment
- Copy of Student ID and Identity Card (IC)
- Family Income Documents e.g., salary slip, income tax return, or statutory declaration
- Personal Statement
- Recommendation Letter (if applicable)
- Proof of Participation in Volunteer Activities (if any)
- Guarantor Forms Signed by Two Guarantors
- Character Evaluation Form
- Other Supporting Documents (if any)
