Eligibility Criteria

The scholarship applicant must: -

1. Be a citizen of Malaysia; and
2. Be enrolled in for Academic Year 2018/2019 intake in any one of the following programme of studies and who have the qualification of a minimum 5As in SPM or equivalent; and

Faculty of Engineering

- Diploma in Technology (Electronic Engineering)
- Diploma in Technology (Materials and Manufacturing Engineering)
- Diploma in Technology (Mechanical and Manufacturing Engineering)
- Diploma in Technology (Mechatronics)

Faculty of Built Environment

- Diploma in Technology (Quantity Surveying)
- Diploma in Technology (Property Management)
- Diploma in Technology (Building)

Faculty of Social Science, Arts and Humanities

- Diploma in Hospitality Management (Hotel Management)
- Diploma in Hotel Management
- Diploma in Culinary Arts

Faculty of Accountancy, Finance and Business

- Diploma in Business Studies (All programmes)
- Diploma in Banking and Finance
- Diploma in Entrepreneurship

3. Be from a household who earns a gross income of not more than RM5,000 per month.
4. Not be an adjudged bankrupt or have any previous convictions, whether in Malaysia or elsewhere.

Value of Scholarship

1. **Full fees charged for the Diploma studies and living allowance.**
2. The tenure of the scholarship is only for the **normal duration** to complete the Diploma course.

Terms & Conditions

1. The scholarship recipient's eligibility will be reviewed on an annual basis and any extensions for a successive year **will be granted** at the absolute discretion of OSK Foundation and subject to the scholarship recipient's satisfactory performance. A written application accompanied by certified true copies of current examination results and semester fee invoice/bill (by the University College) must be made every semester.
2. During the course of study, the scholarship recipient is not allowed to receive any financial assistance from or under any grant or scholarship for his/her programme of study.
3. The scholarship recipient is required to maintain a CGPA of 2.800 every semester.
4. The scholarship recipient is required to undergo/fulfil a minimum of 20 hours of community volunteering service per semester. He/she is required to get a signature from the beneficiary as proof of the volunteering services done and is required to submit a report to OSK Foundation at the end of each semester.
5. **Internship/Practical Training** at OSK Group or its affiliates is **compulsory** if internship is required as part of the programme of study.

Application

1. Candidate may download the application form from TAR UC website at the beginning of the May Semester.
2. Completed application with relevant documents must be submitted to the Department of Student Affairs at Main Campus or to the Student Affairs Office at the Branch Campuses on or before the closing date stipulated in the application form.
3. Only **shortlisted candidates** will be required to attend an **interview**.
