## TAR UC – TAA SCHOLARSHIP

TAR UC - TAA Scholarship is established to provide scholarships to TAR UC registered students or graduates who demonstrate high academic achievements and participation in student activities to pursue their further studies in TAR UC undergraduate or postgraduate programmes.

### Eligibility Criteria:

1. Have been admitted into TAR UC's undergraduate or postgraduate programme, and
2. Must be a Malaysian citizen, and
3. Must be a former TAR UC student who possesses Cambridge GCE A Level or a TAR UC Foundation / Diploma / Bachelor Degree who is graduated with minimum CGPA of 3.5000, and
4. Financial needy, and/or
5. Active participation in extra-curricular activities

### Value of Scholarship Award:

University's Tuition Fees as per the university's bill for the duration of the programme.

### Terms and Conditions:

1. Shortlisted applicants shall be required to attend selection interviews.
2. Successful applicant must confirm acceptance of the scholarship award within 1 week of offer, failing which the scholarship offer shall automatically lapse.
3. Successful applicant has to sign an agreement with the TAR UC and abide by the terms and conditions as set therein.
4. The scholarship recipient's eligibility will be reviewed on an annual basis and any extensions for a successive year will be granted at the absolute discretion of TAR UC and subject to the scholarship recipient's satisfactory performance and conduct.
5. Scholarship holder must maintain good academic results or otherwise every semester.
6. All scholarships are not transferable or exchangeable for cash.
7. Scholarship holder maybe required to perform a [Service Bond](#) at a company nominated by TARCian Alumni Association (TAA) upon graduation. The applicable period for the Service Bond shall be determined solely based on the scholarship awarded as shown below:

Total Scholarship Awarded	Applicable Bond Period (Year)
20,000.00-39,999.99	One (1)
40,000.00-59,999.99	Two (2)
Above 60,000.00	Three (3)

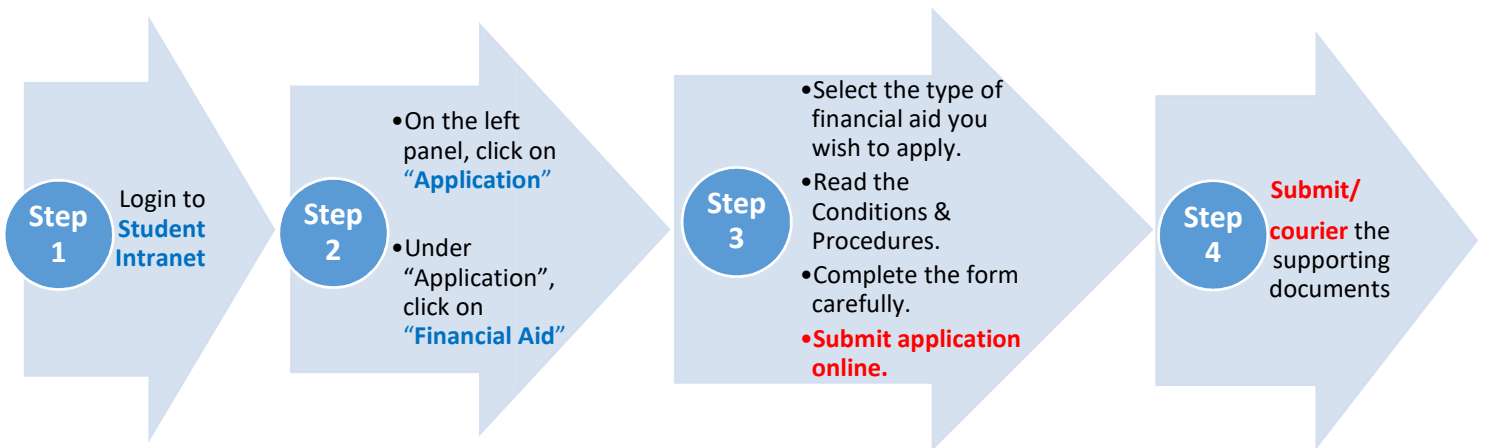
8. Scholarship holder shall not change his/her programme of studies unless with written permission from the TAR UC.
9. Scholarship holder may be required to reimburse the scholarship award amount received up to date of termination / withdrawal / suspension, in case of termination / withdrawal / suspension from the University enrolled in.
10. Scholarship holders shall not be simultaneously receiving scholarship from other organizations / agencies unless with written approval from TAR UC.

11. TAR UC reserves the right to involve the scholarship recipient in interviews, advertisements, photography or other publicity-related activities for promotion purpose.
12. Terms and conditions of TAR UC - TAA Scholarship may be modified and amended from time to time as deemed appropriate by TAR UC.
13. The decision of TAR UC Student Scholarship Committee shall be final and conclusive. No appeal shall be entertained.

### Application Procedures:

1. **Apply Online** through **Student Intranet from a Computer**. Online application opens in **June**.



2. The completed **application form shall be printed out and submitted / couriered together with all supporting documents** as listed in the application form to the Department of Student Affairs at KL Main Campus or to the Student Affairs Office at the Branch Campuses before the stipulated closing date.

*The application **will lapse automatically** if you failed to submit the complete form & documents within the given time frame.*

3. Shortlisted applicants are required to attend an **interview** sessions. The Faculties/Branch Campus will notify the applicants regarding details of the interview via email / phone calls / message.
