TAR UMT JINBODHI BURSARY

TAR UMT JINBODHI Bursary is established to provide bursary to underprivileged students to further their studies in TAR UMT.

Eligibility:

- 1. Must be a Malaysian citizen.
- 2. Students who obtained admission to TAR UMT for full time **diploma or degree programmes** with at least one more year of studies before completing the current programme of studies.
- 3. Be from a household who earns a combined income of **not more than RM5,000 per month**.

Note:

- 1. Students who have applied to the TAR UMT Jinbodhi Bursary in Nov 2023 semester are NOT eligible.
- 2. Students enrolled for Nov 2024 Intake are NOT eligible.

Value of the Award:

Full fees charged for the programme of studies (up to max RM10,000 per annum, up to a max of RM30,000 per recipient for the full programme of study).


Terms and Conditions:

- 1. Successful applicant has to sign an acceptance letter and agree to abide by the terms and conditions as set therein.
- 2. The bursary recipient's eligibility will be reviewed on an annual basis and any extensions for a successive year will be granted at the absolute discretion of TAR UMT and subject to the recipient's satisfactory performance and conduct.
- 3. During the course of study, the recipient is not allowed to receive other scholarship, bursary, award of a monetary nature without prior written consent of TAR UMT.
- 4. The recipients are required to achieve a minimum **GPA of 2.7500** every semester in addition to the current requirement of maintaining a **CGPA of 2.7500** and above every semester.
- 5. Dropping of subject(s) is not permitted.
- 6. The bursary will be disbursed through the Bursary of TAR UMT.
- 7. The bursary is not transferable or exchangeable for cash.
- 8. Upon graduation thereof, the recipient may be offered an employment under Bodhi Meditation Charity Foundation or any of its appointed organisations SUBJECT ALWAYS to the availability of a suitable vacancy relevant to the recipient's programme of study. Acceptance of the employment offer shall be at the recipient's sole discretion at the time of offer. Rejection of the offer shall not in any way affect the bursary granted herein. Nothing in this clause shall be deemed and/or construed as an obligation on the part of Bodhi Meditation Charity Foundation or any of its appointed organisations to procure and/or secure employment for the recipient.
- 9. The recipient is required to be involved in at least one (1) Bodhi Meditation Charity Foundation's event per year provided always this shall not jeopardise the recipient's studies.

Application Procedures:

1. Online Application is to be made via Student Intranet in <u>July</u>.



2. The completed application form shall be **printed out and submitted by hand / couriered together with all supporting documents** as listed in the application form to the Financial Aid Unit, Department of Student Affairs at KL Main Campus or to the Student Affairs Office at the Branch Campuses before the stipulated closing date.

Note: The application will <u>lapse automatically</u> if you failed to submit the complete form & documents within the given time frame.

- 3. Applicants who have been shortlisted for the interview must attend the interview sessions. The Faculties/ Branch Campus / Sponsor (Bodhi Meditation Charity Foundation) will contact shortlisted applicants via email, phone call, or text message to provide the interview details. Hence, applicants are advised to check their emails, phone calls, and text messages regularly.
