1. Applicant must be pursuing full-time Diploma or Foundation or Bachelor Degree programme of studies in Tunku Abdul Rahman University College.
2. Applicant should be financially needy and deserving.
3. Applicant must be a Malaysian citizen.

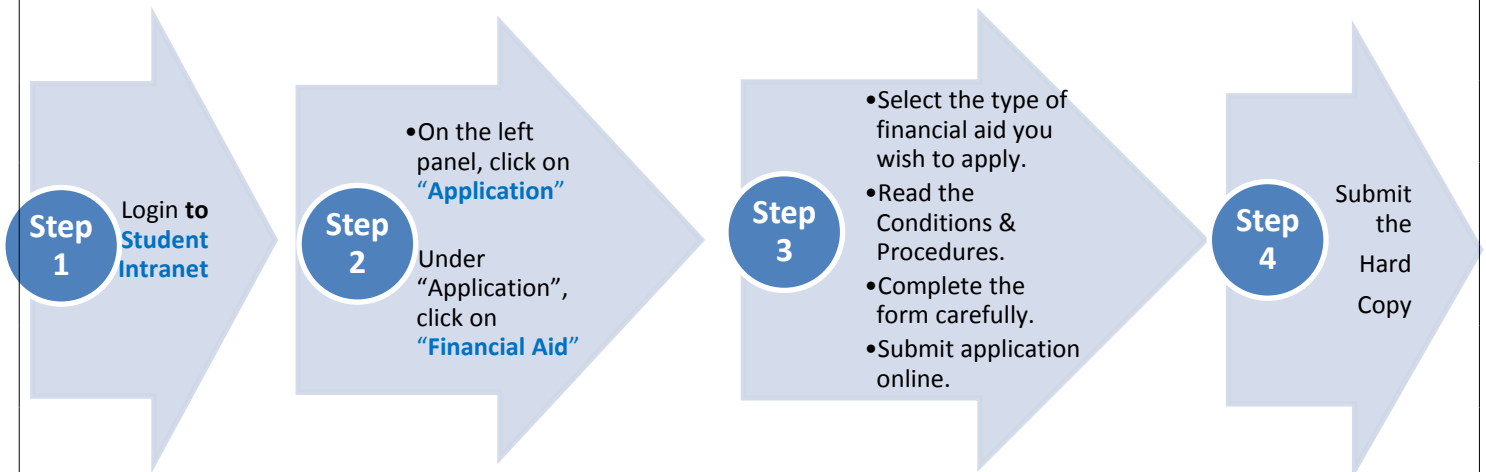
**PTPTN loan holders are allowed to apply for TAR UC Student Loan Fund.*

Amount per Award

1. The value of TAR UC Student Loan award for each academic year is up to maximum RM15,000.
2. The value for TAR UC Student Loan award for each applicant will be determined by the TAR UC Student Loan Fund Committee taking into consideration the applicant's financial circumstances, academic performance and character.
3. Continuation of loan award is subject to annual review of loan holder's academic performance and character.

Procedures for Applications

1. **Online Application** is to be made via Student Intranet in the first 2 weeks of the semester.



2. The completed application form shall be **printed out and submitted together with all supporting documents** as listed below to the respective Faculty's/Centre's office at KL Main Campus or to the Student Affairs Office at the Branch Campuses latest by the end of the third Friday of the semester.
 - a. Student's Identity Card (Kad Pengenalan).
 - b. SPM/STPM/TAR UC examination results/results of other education qualifications.
 - c. Documents/certificates on extracurricular activities, if any.
 - d. Proof of parents'/guardian's income.
 - e. Latest family household electricity bill.
 - f. Any other relevant documents in support of the application (i.e. death certificate, etc).

*The application **will lapse** if you failed to submit the complete form & documents within the given time frame.*



3. All applicants are required to attend an **interview** to be conducted by the respective Faculties/ Centre/ Branch Campuses. Please check with the respective Faculties/ Centre/ Branch Campuses regarding the date, time and venue for the interviews.
4. Successful applicants are required to sign an **agreement between TAR UC, Borrower and TWO (2) Guarantors**.
