TAR UC – TAA Scholarship (TOP GLOVE)

TAR UC - TAA Scholarship (TOP GLOVE) is established to provide scholarships to TAR UC registered students who demonstrate high academic achievements and participation in student activities to pursue their further studies in TAR UC.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Must be a Malaysian citizen, and
- 2. Must be a TAR UC Bachelor Degree student with minimum CGPA of 3.5000, and/or
- 3. Active participation in extra-curricular activities.

Value of Scholarship Award:

University's **tuition fees** as per the university's bill and additional **monthly living allowance of RM1,000** for the duration of the programme.

Terms and Conditions:


- 1. The applicant must not be bonded to any other body or organization.
- 2. Shortlisted applicants shall be required to attend a selection interview.
- 3. Successful applicant has to sign an agreement with the TAR UC and Top Glove Foundation, and abide by the terms and conditions as set therein.
- 4. Scholarship recipient shall not be simultaneously receiving scholarship / financial assistance / bursaries from other organizations / agencies unless with written approval from TAR UC.
- 5. All scholarships are not transferable or exchangeable for cash.
- 6. Scholarship recipient must maintain a CGPA of 3.2500 and above every semester.
- 7. The scholarship recipient's eligibility will be reviewed on a semester basis and any extensions for a successive year will be granted at the absolute discretion of TAR UC and subject to the scholarship recipient's satisfactory performance and conduct.
- 8. Scholarship recipient shall not change his/her programme of studies unless with written permission from the TAR UC.
- 9. Scholarship recipient will be required to be employed in any entity within the TOP GLOVE GROUP OF COMPANIES according to the total duration of time the Scholarship was provided upon completion of studies.
- 10. Scholarship recipient will be required to pay back double the amount of the total scholarship granted, in case of termination of the scholarship award, withdrawal / suspension from the Programme of Studies, failure to complete the service bond, or breaches any of the terms and conditions of the scholarship agreement.

- 11. TAR UC reserves the right to involve the scholarship recipient in interviews, advertisements, photography or other publicity-related activities for promotion purpose.
- 12. Terms and conditions of TAR UC TAA Scholarship (Top Glove) may be modified and amended from time to time as deemed appropriate by TAR UC.
- 13. The decision of TAR UC Student Scholarship and Bursary Committee shall be final and conclusive. No appeal shall be entertained.

Application Procedures:

1. Apply Online through <u>Student Intranet from a Computer</u>. Online application opens in <u>June</u>.



2. The completed **application form shall be printed out and submitted / couriered together with all supporting documents** as listed in the application form to the Department of Student Affairs at KL Main Campus or to the Student Affairs Office at the Branch Campuses before the stipulated closing date.

The application <u>will lapse automatically</u> if you failed to submit the complete form & documents within the given time frame.

- 3. Shortlisted applicants are required to attend an **interview** sessions. The Faculties/Branch Campus will notify the applicants regarding details of the online interview via email / phone calls / message.
