

Student Enquiries on Orientation Week

1. Is it compulsory to attend the Orientation?
It is compulsory for all new students to attend the Orientation.
2. What is the purpose of attending the Orientation?
The purpose of attending the orientation is to help new students make a smooth transition to University College life and to get to know each other.
3. What are the activities or programmes during the Orientation?
The Orientation consists of Mass Call, Meet Your Faculty Session, Society Day, Adjustment to Campus Life activities, Introduction to Tertiary Education Workshop, Games & Sports, KL Tour, Talentime Night and Orientation Odyssey Night.
4. What should new students bring for the Mass Call/Orientation?
All new students are required to bring their payment details' advice.
5. Are there any Orientation materials to be collected?
All new students will get an orientation kit during Mass Call/Orientation.
6. Can new students attend the Orientation before paying the programme fees/ before registering for a programme of study?
New students who have yet to pay the programme fees are not allowed to attend the Orientation.
7. What time does the activities or programmes end during the Orientation?
The activities will end at approximately 5.30pm during the Orientation.
8. What is the dress code during the Orientation?
New students should dress 'smart casual' during the Orientation.
9. Does the University College allow parents to accompany new students during the Orientation?
It is not necessary for parents to accompany new students during the Orientation. Parents are encouraged to present to talk to the Faculty academic staff.

10. Do parents need to be present with new students at the Orientation?
Parents are not required to be present with the new students at the Orientation.
11. What will happen if new students do not attend the Orientation?
It is compulsory for all new students to attend the Orientation.
12. Can new students park their vehicles in the University College without a valid vehicle sticker?
Only vehicles with valid University College vehicle entry pass are allowed inside the University College compound.
13. Can a new student who cannot attend the morning session Mass Call be given a choice to attend the afternoon session Mass Call?
New students must attend the Mass Call according to schedule.
14. If any new students miss the first day of the Orientation, where should they report?
For new students who have missed the first day of the Orientation, they may collect the Orientation schedule at the Department of Student Affairs and to report to their respective Faculties.
