Chengdu ASEAN Arts Scholarship



1. Introduction

The College of Chinese & ASEAN Arts, Chengdu University is offering scholarships for foreigners to pursue Bachelor’s Degree and Master’s Degree programmes at the University. Successful candidates will receive full scholarship which covers tuition fees, accommodation, medical insurance and utility expenses.

2. The Scholarship

RMB 30,000 per year worth of scholarship will be given to each successful applicants for Bachelor Degree programme, and RMB 36,000 per year worth of scholarship will be given to each successful applicants for Master’s Degree programme. The scholarship covers tuition fees, accommodation including utility cost, medical insurance and RMB 1,000 living expenses per month for 10 months each year. 100 scholarships are available for Malaysians, successful applicants will be short-listed based on the merit of academic result.

3. The Programmes

4. Supporting Documents:

- (i) Official certificate of award **AND** academic transcripts (high school, A Level, UEC, Diploma or Bachelor Degree)
- (ii) Artwork/ Portfolio/ Music Performance Recording supporting their application*
- (iii) 1 copy of **ALL** pages of valid passport (cover to cover including blank pages)

***Artwork / Portfolio / Recording Requirements (Priority will be given to applicants with supporting artworks)**

Fine Art (including Animation and Design):

Electronic version of 3 sets of work that can represent applicant's aptitude for drawing.

Music Performance (including Music Instrument Performance and Singing):

3-5 minutes recording of applicant's live performance (editing not permitted).

Radio & Television Editing (including Video Programme Production, Video Culture & New Media Arts):

3-5 minutes recording of video clip that can represent applicant's aptitude for video editing.

100 Scholarships are available for application. Scan and submit softcopy of duly completed application form and supporting documents to sau.cpe@tarc.edu.my latest by 30th May 2018. Acknowledgement of receipt will be made via email for complete submission.

Note: Early bird discount of RM1000 on Service & Administration Fees for successful applicant who has submitted his/her application before May 2018.

TAR UC forward application forms and supporting documents to the College of Chinese & ASEAN Arts, Chengdu University.

The College of Chinese & ASEAN Arts, Chengdu University issue offer letter to successful applicants within 1.5 months upon receiving submission through TAR UC .

Successful applicants will collect offer letter from Study Abroad Unit, CPE, TAR UC.

Successful applicants pay a one-off Service & Administration Fees (RM10k + GST for 2 years Master's Degree programmes ; RM14k + GST for 4 years Bachelor's Degree programmes) to TAR UC, and collect JW202 Form at SAU, CPE, TAR UC on acceptance of offer.

Note: TAR UC Diploma graduates articulating into Year 3 Bachelor's Degree programmes at the College of Chinese & ASEAN Arts, Chengdu University will pay RM 10k + GST for the one-off Service & Administration Fees.

TAR UC forward successful applicant's acceptance of offer to the College of Chinese & ASEAN Arts, Chengdu University.

Students apply Visa at China Embassy in Malaysia (bring along duly completed JW202 form and Offer Letter from the College of Chinese & ASEAN Arts, Chengdu University) and purchase air tickets. All students MUST arrive on the same date and will be received by the College of Chinese & ASEAN Arts, Chengdu University representatives at the airport.

Other expenses payable by students include:

Medical checkup	RMB 500 (one-off payment)
China Temporary Residence Permit	RMB 1200 (one-off payment)
Learning materials	RMB 300 – 600 annually
