Formed in 2015, the Centre evolved from the Institute of Applied Entrepreneurship (IAE). She is experienced in enterprise education, leading on the development of the Masters in Enterprise and Entrepreneurship Education and co-delivering the International Enterprise Educators Programme (IEEP).
