TUNKU Abdul Rahman University College (TAR UC) will celebrate its 50th anniversary on March 16 and 17.

Its president, Professor Dr Lee Sze Wei, said the celebration, themed "HomeComing", is the perfect opportunity for alumni to reconnect over a series of programmes and activities.

He said alumni, current students and the public will find themselves jogging down memory lane.

On the the first day, he said, there will be sharing sessions, showcases, a concert and a forum where industry partners and special guests will discuss the future of education.

"Our 50th anniversary celebrations will be held on the second day at all TAR UC campuses, but the main one will be at the

main campus.
