This environment, comprising a holistic approach towards system design, learning platform, server architecture, coupled with edUtorium - the staff development programme and pedagogical design has resulted in a high immersive and adoption rate, by both staff and students.

Through this innovative eLearning initiative, the University has won recognition by being a winner of the Intelligent20 Award 2003, Honouree of CIO Asia100 Award 2004, EMC Best Practice Award 2004, and the National Health Group Distinguished Contributor Award 2005.
