## **Biodata**

Professor Rupert Maclean is Chair Professor of International Education in the Department of Policy and Administration and Director of the Centre for Lifelong Learning Research and Development, in the Hong Kong Institute of Education. He concurrently holds the honorary positions of Senior Research Fellow, University of Oxford, Department of Education, England; Adjunct Professor, School of Education, Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology (RMIT) University, Melbourne, Australia; Visiting Professor of International Education, School of Education, East China Normal University, Shanghai; Special Advisor on Curriculum Development and Reform concerning Technical and Vocational Education and Training, Zhejiang Technology Institute of Economy, Hangzhou Province, China; and, Member, Advisory Board, Colombo Plan Staff Training College (CPSC), Manila, Philippines.

Immediately prior to joining the Hong Kong Institute of Education in July 2009, Professor Maclean was the Foundation Director of the UNESCO International Centre for Technical and Vocational Education and Training, Bonn, Germany, for eight years. In 2007-2008, he was Chairperson of the Committee of the Heads of the (23) United Nations Agencies in Germany. Prior to this, he was Director of Secondary Education, UNESCO Paris; Chief of the Asia-Pacific Centre of Educational Innovation for Development, UNESCO Bangkok; and, UNESCO's Chief Technical Advisor for a United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) to reform and strengthen teacher education in Myanmar.

His research specialization are education in developing, transition and post-conflict countries; educational innovation for development; skills development for employability; educational disadvantage; teacher education reform; and, sociology of teachers as an occupational group.

He has published many books, chapters in books, research reports, journal articles, and numerous book reviews, editorials, series editors introductions, chapters in conference proceedings and other articles. Professor Maclean is the editor of two international book series. Some of his publications have been translated from English into Chinese, French, Arabic, Russian, Japanese, and/or Spanish.

He is the founding father of the Asia-Pacific Educational Research Association (APERA) and the Association's international journal Educational Research for Policy and Practice. He has given numerous invited keynote addresses at major international conferences, for example, 49 keynote addresses have been given over the past five years.
