Dr. Eva Wong is the Director of the Centre for Holistic Teaching and Learning (CHTL) at Hong Kong Baptist University (HKBU). The Centre has major responsibilities for the professional development of faculty members and teaching staff, assisting the implementation of the outcomes-based approach to teaching and learning, supporting the University's e-learning endeavours, aiding evidence collection for the assessment of students' attainment of learning outcomes, and helping students' whole person development with the aim of enhancing student learning with a holistic approach.

Dr. Wong was educated in the United Kingdom, received her first degree in Electrical & Electronic Engineering from University College London, and a Ph.D. in Information Systems from the University of Abertay Dundee. She worked in a number of tertiary institutions in the United Kingdom, including the University of Dundee, University of Cambridge and University of Essex, during the earlier part of her career in computer science and information systems before returning to Hong Kong with her family in 1991. Dr. Wong joined the City University of Hong Kong (CityU) as a faculty member in the Department of Information System, and received the University's 1996-1997 Teaching Excellence Award. With her IT background, Dr. Wong's current interests and expertise are in the enhancement of student learning through the use of engaging and learner-centred pedagogies leveraged on e-Learning, in which area she has presented and published.
