

Professor David Lloyd
Vice Chancellor and President, the University of South Australia

David Lloyd was appointed to the University of South Australia as Vice Chancellor and President in 2012. A Dublin-born and educated chemist who specialises in computer-aided drug design, Professor Lloyd has re-focused institutional culture to position UniSA as Australia's university of enterprise and to shape its activities to better meet the challenges of the 21st century.

In 2014 Professor Lloyd was appointed to the South Australia Economic Development Board (EDB) and in 2015 he was appointed Chair of the Australian Technology Network group of technology-focused universities.

Before joining the University of South Australia, Professor Lloyd was Vice-president for Research and later Bursar and Director of Strategic Innovation at Trinity College Dublin. Professor Lloyd was Chair of the Irish Research Council and prior to academia, worked in the pharmaceutical industry in the UK. He holds an honorary Professorship from Tainjin University and is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Chemistry.

David qualified with a Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Applied Chemistry and a PhD in Medicinal Organic Chemistry from Dublin City University. He also holds an MA (*j.o.*) from Trinity College Dublin.
